



Program Eligibility For Individuals:

(specific to Healing Intensives)

ELIGIBILITY: In order to be eligible for a scholarship program, client must meet the following criteria:

1. Client must prove that they meet at least ONE of the following:
 - (a) A Service Industry Worker exhibiting extreme burnout (i.e. EMS worker, healthcare worker, nurses aid, ministry worker, teacher, therapist, etc).
 - (b) A victim of human trafficking who has recently been rescued and is in need of counseling
2. Client must ALSO meet TWO of the Following Criteria:
 - (a) Client is unemployed or under-employed (income less than \$40,000 per year or are unable to work more than 20 hours per week due to physical or mental inability or illness)- client must produce most recent tax return or determination of disability by disability determination services of Social Security Administration.
 - (b) Client's monthly bills for daily living is equal to or more than their monthly income - client must provide recent pay stubs.
 - (c) Client has lack of transportation to sessions.
 - (d) Client's insurance does not cover a particular wellness service to include but not limited to: healing intensives, wellness retreats, gut health testing, or health coaching.
 - (e) Client has 2 or more dependents.

CLIENT'S OBLIGATIONS: To continue to receive scholarship funds, a client must:

1. Sign scholarship receipt and **include** which practitioner they will be seeing, along with start date.

2. Attend all scholarship activities, programs, classes or sessions.
3. Actively work with the wellness provider towards treatment goals, and inform the wellness/healthcare provider if there should be any changes made to treatment goals.
4. Prepare and return the attached Report of Scholarship Activities each month; and
5. Miss no more than 2 consecutive sessions, or more than 2 during any 3-month period.
6. Utilize all scholarship funds or sessions awarded before then end of a 4 month period or forfeit the remainder of their scholarship.
7. **COMPLETE & SEND BACK** the client follow up survey for the purposes of grant tracking and program performance.

** Failure to abide by above obligations will result in not being eligible for future programming opportunities. **
